Need a lift?

A liftgate is a hydraulic platform attached to the back of trucks or trailers that makes loading and unloading freight safer and easier. Liftgate service makes freight delivery more efficient, secure and accessible.

Liftgates are hydraulically powered platforms installed on the rear of a truck or trailer. With the push of a button, the liftgate raises or lowers to the appropriate height, ground level or truck bed, making it easier to load or unload freight directly.

Some liftgates fold under the truck bed when not in use, while others lay flat against the back door. Common operating features include toggle switches or handheld controls, safety features like automatic stops or ramps and manual overrides in case of a power failure.

At MX Logistics, most of our trailers come equipped with liftgate, allowing us to ensure smooth and efficient freight deliveries when the origin or destination has no loading dock.

You'll most commonly find liftgates installed on box trucks, straight trucks, dry vans and refrigerated trailers (also known as reefer trucks). Learn more about what is the best trailer to transport freight.

PROS

Liftgates that go the extra mile

A liftgate is essential if your delivery location doesn't have a loading dock or where equipment is limited. It's also recommended when your freight is over 150 pounds, not palletized, if there's no forklift or unloading crew available at the drop-off point. A liftgate can reduce risk of damage, delays and unnecessary physical harm.

There are three important things to look at when it comes to liftgate service:

- Larger platforms: More space means it's easier to move big freight.
- High weight capacity: MX liftgates can handle up to 4,400 lbs, which covers everything from small deliveries to heavy pallets.
- Solar-powered battery systems: These keep the liftgates running without needing to rely on the truck engine. Less downtime and it's better for the environment too.





There are two main types of liftgates: rail-style liftgates, which are mounted directly to the rear of the truck, and tuck-under liftgates, which fold and store beneath the truck when not in use.






This is what a liftgate looks like when it's fully deployed. This model is a tuck-under liftgate.
